Last spring it was suggested that the Vice President/President-Elect chair an annual CE committee to plan a continuing education program for the membership at the spring meeting.

• Should we add that to the list of VP/P-E responsibilities in the Bylaws? If so, here's some proposed language:

Article VII Officers

Section 3 - Vice President/President-Elect

The Vice President shall perform all the duties of the President in the absence of the President or as delegated by the President. The Vice President shall also be the President-Elect, and shall be responsible for contacting new members and inviting the new state librarians to Western Council, and shall serve as chair of the CE committee.

 Should we add a CE committee to the list of standing committees in the Bylaws? If so, here's some proposed language:

Article IX Committees

Section 1 - Appointments

The President shall appoint the chair of all committees with the exception of the chair of the Nominating Committee <u>and the CE Committee</u>. The President shall appoint the members of all standing committees, with the exception of the Executive Committee, and any ad hoc committees designated by the members or the Executive Committee. The President shall be an ex officio member of all committees.

Section 2 - Standing Committees

The Standing Committees shall be as follows:

- 1. Nominating Committee
- 2. Executive Committee
- 3. <u>CE Committee</u>
